

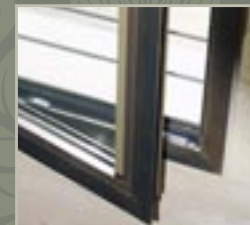

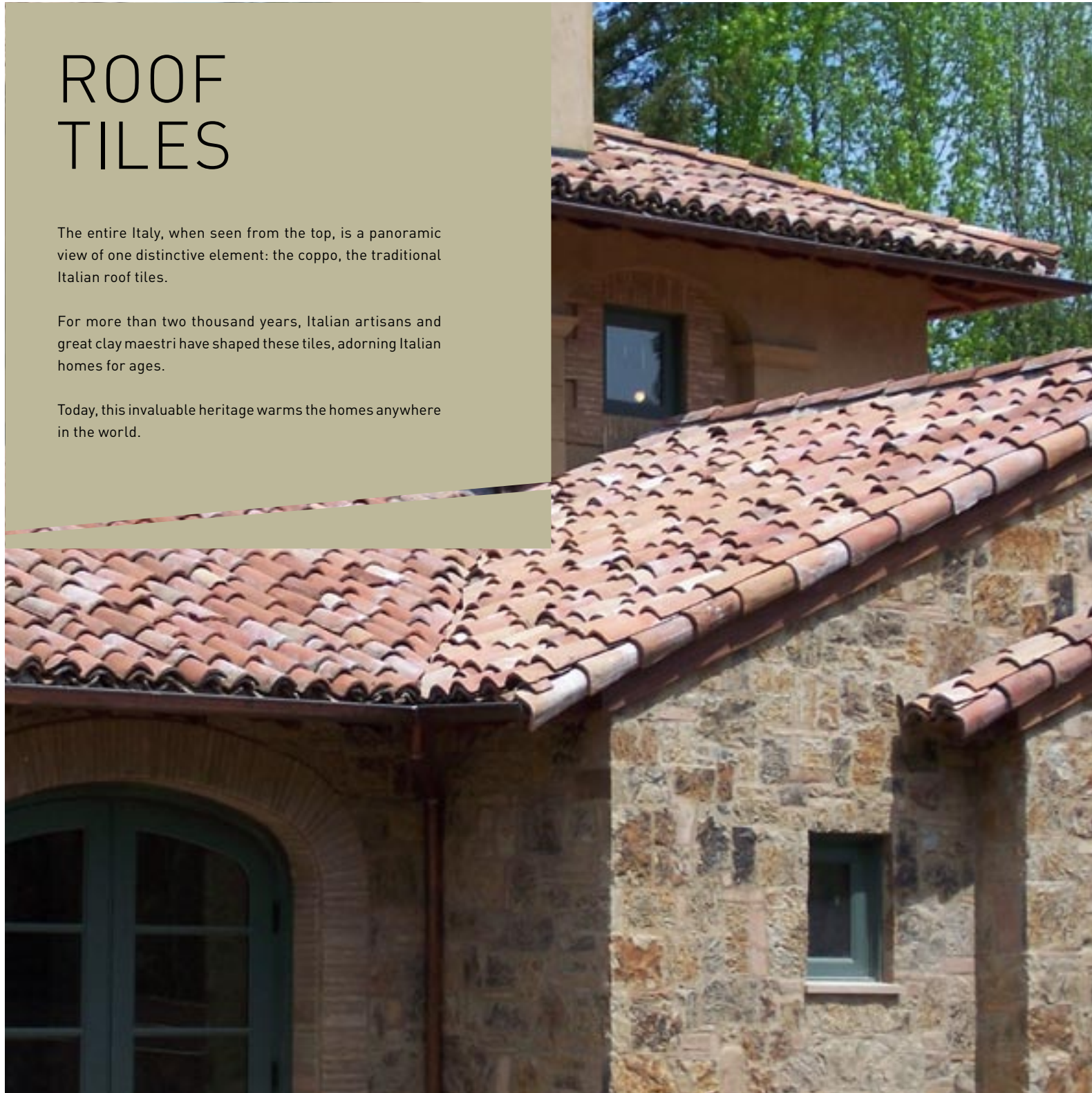

In collaboration with Brombal Serramenti, CoorItalia introduces a line of custom metal windows and doors manufactured in Italy. Featuring the Bronzofinestra, a burnished brass that provides a beautiful and antique bronze finish, the steel cor-ten, and stainless steel. All the units can be upgraded with a thermal break system.

Our line of Italian made windows and doors in wood are produced using a non endangered wood species. Available options are the exterior cladding in aluminum or bronze for maintenance free product.

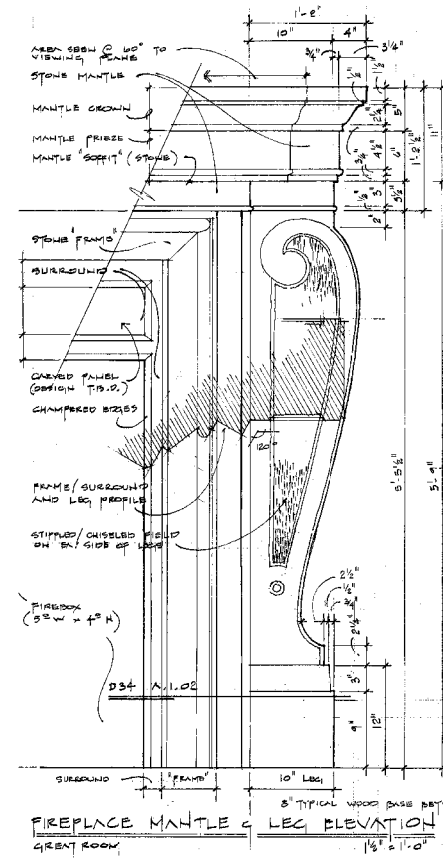

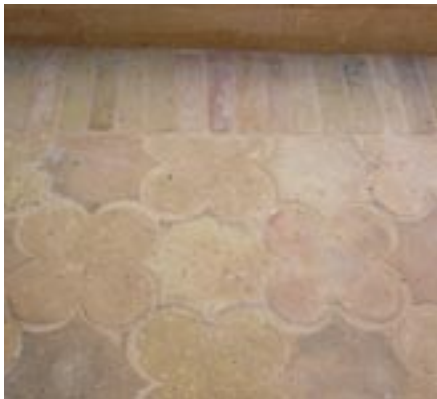
